STANDING RULES

I. General Rules of Order

The rules in the current edition of Robert's Rules of Order shall govern all meetings in all cases to which they are applicable and in which they are not inconsistent with the articles of incorporation, bylaws and other rules of order of the Cornerstone Credit Union League.

II. Decorum and Debate

- **A.** Certified delegates, directors and the president shall be permitted the use and privilege of the floor.
- **B.** A delegate desiring the floor shall address the presiding officer as Mr. Chairman and give his name and credit union which he represents.
- **C.** DEBATE. No person may speak longer than five (5) minutes on the same question without permission of the assembly. He may speak the second time only after others have had an opportunity to speak.
- **D.** VOTING. All voting shall be in one of the following manners:

1. Voice 3. Rising 5. Electronic

2. Show of Hands 4. Paper Ballot

The presiding officer may designate one of the prescribed methods of voting on any question, but all contested elections shall be by ballot. Any delegate may move that the vote on a question be by ballot.
